Father Alister Anderson, Col./Chaplain. USA Retired, Annapolis Class of 45, World War II veteran, US Navy and Vietnam US Army.

Adrian Cronaur, Esq., subject of the movie: "Good Morning, Vietnam." and supporter of the proposed Flag Amendment.

Admiral James 'Ace' Lyons, US Navy. Ret. A true conservative, who blessed us with his friendship, guidance and energy.

You will notice that conspicuously absent from the departed patriots are Senator John McCain and former President George H.W. Bush, neither of whom do I consider honorable.
